


Tech Tip for opening multiple browser tabs in Microsoft Internet Explorer (IE)

This setting allows you to open multiple browser tabs in IE with the click of the home button, or on the startup of IE. The benefit of this is that you can set up you most common websites for immediate viewing

Open Microsoft Internet Explorer (IE)

Navigate to the right hand side Tools icon

Select “Internet Options” below:



We are attempting to place three websites in the home page tab as highlighted above.

Hint the order you apply the websites is the order that they will appear on the screen

Method:

Find your first website and copy the URL by highlighting and CTR C or right click your mouse, Select COPY.

Open the “Internet Options” as described above and copy the URL into the “Home Page” dialogue,

In this example I have used **https://www.fitbit.com/**

Select “Apply” button in the bottom right hand side.

Then copy your second website, and reopen the “Internet Options” as described above

This attempt place an **ENTER** or **RETURN** at the end of the first website URL, this will copy the URL to the second line

In this example I have used **https://www.bing.com/**

Then copy your second website URL into the “Home Page” dialogue.

Use the above method to copy in the remaining websites.

Select “Apply” button to finish

To prove your result close Microsoft Internet Explorer (IE)

Then open Microsoft Internet Explorer (IE) – your new websites should appear.
